OX-EYE DAISY

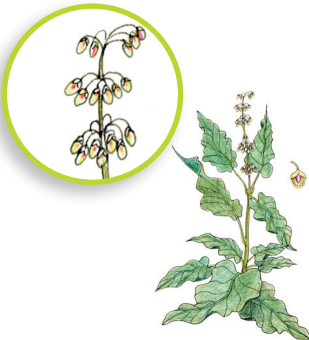
(*Chrysanthemum leucanthemum*)

(*Urtica dioica*)



* June - September

(*Chenopodium album*)



* July - September

MUGWORT

(*Artemisia vulgaris*)



* July - September

RAGWEED

(*Ambrosia artemisiifolia*)



* August - October

TIPS ON REDUCING EXPOSURE

- Keep your garden weed-free as much as possible
- Exercise your pet on well-cut paths and pavements; avoiding areas with an overgrowth of weeds
- Regularly groom, wipe over with a damp cloth or rinse your pet off with water, especially after exposure to weeds
- Monitor your local pollen forecast
- Be aware that species related to the named allergen can also be problematic
