* The samples are examined under a microscope to look for bacteria, yeast and also various types of mites and other parasites or fungi.

** The hairs are examined under the microscope to look for mites, fungi and to check hair growth.

- ☐ Anal sacs emptied
- ☐ Blood sample/s taken for:

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*** A sample is taken and sent to the laboratory to identify what fungi are present (the hair pluck sample may also be used for this purpose).

**** A swab is taken to identify what bacteria are present on the skin/in the ear. The swab is sent to a laboratory and they will also work out which antibiotics will be effective against the bacteria.
